The district is also having other meetings during the next several weeks to gain additional insight from parents on how to help overcome this deficit.

Writing SIP has looked at the first cycle data to see what needs attention, continued a book study, and writing workshops. Student Achievement SIP talked about programs, some glitches, but still celebrating successes. Pre-K SIP is helping support students moving into the next level, Kindergarten. Behavior SIP has moved mountains defining school wide behaviors.
